THE DAILY LESSON – July 1, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“Good morning. Nobody's going to believe that kind of a "good morning." (*Laughter*) I can hear our friends way out in Seattle saying, "We don't greet you that way.”

We are sitting out here in the home beginning a very, very unusual work, an unusual work for the message of The Infinite Way. We're gathered here in my home. Certainly we are in a setting that should provide inspiration—close to the sea, in tremendous groves of coconut palms, and above all things we have here peace and quiet. A quiet that isn't attainable in many places on the globe any more. And besides that, we have something else that is far beyond price. We have a united Consciousness of students who have come from far places, some from close at hand, to unite in this one Consciousness, in this Consciousness of God's presence.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 2, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“Every one of us has problems of some nature, of some degree, problems of human existence. It would be an impossibility to ‘live in the world’ even though one weren’t ‘of the world’ and not have some problems either of personal experience or family if not these, community, national, international. And we start off with the understanding that we are blessed in that we have these problems. Not that we are cursed, but that we are blessed. Without problems, a human stagnates.

That is one reason why when men and women retire from business, they quickly become invalids or pass from our sight. They have no problems. They haven’t enough to keep their interests awake, alert. And if they haven’t made contact with their own inner being, they have no inspiration with which to meet the daily experience. And so, for the greater part of our journey, we must be grateful for problems. In the case of students of The Infinite Way, this is even truer than of others.” ~Joel

“You will note in the literature of the day that the world is seeking peace, safety, and security. It is seeking a peace which is based on safety and security. This means to the world that if there are no active wars going on, that they feel safe. It means that if we are not in the midst of a depression, that they feel secure. All of this is a false sense of safety and a false sense of security because the peace of today can be war tomorrow. The boom of today can be the bust of tomorrow. The health of today can be the accident or the disease of tomorrow, and so this frantic search for safety and security is absolutely hopeless, fruitless, and a tremendous waste of time and energy.” ~Joel

“In the metaphysical thought there is another step taken—perhaps a higher step—one in which the individual suffering from these human problems seeks to find a power through which they may overcome or meet these problems of human existence, and thereby turn sickness into health, lack into abundance, war into peace. And this is a step upward because the means through which they hope to attain this is either mental or spiritual. At least they are not seeking their good in applications of matter, in just applying a material remedy to a material condition or using one power of matter with which to meet another power of matter.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 5, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

"You see, that is what has gotten the world into this war trouble. In the beginning, wars were fought hand to hand and then with knives and spears, and later with pistols. In each case it was one powerful form of matter over a less powerful form of matter. And always the one who had the more powerful form of matter overcame the other until we got to the age where we won World War II with blockbusters and atom bombs - probably the highest form of matter-force yet known, discovered.

If it were possible for this world to discover a form of power greater than the hydrogen bomb, you wouldn't hear much talk about peace. The world wouldn't be interested in peace. All it would seek would be a stronger form of matter to destroy someone who has the hydrogen bomb and, as long as we had that in our hip pocket or some other nation had it in their hip pocket, the world would be well content.

It is only when we approach a period like this one where the powers of matter are equal on both sides, where the powers of destruction are equal on both sides, that we begin to say, "Can't we settle this without a fight?"

Some of you may remember that the Kaiser went to war because he was sure that he had a secret up his sleeve. He had the submarine which no one else knew about and which was going to overcome the entire armed forces of the rest of the world. He was going to starve out his enemies with submarines. And, of course, in World War II Hitler had his Air Force which was superior to anything in Europe—not only that, it was superior to anything that we had, and that was to be a sudden blitz. And for awhile we had the atomic bomb, so we gave up our—much at least of our – armament until we discovered that someone else had it too." ~Joel

“This same thing happened in the realm of health. Many years ago it was a simple matter when ill to take medicines. But as medicine proved less and less effective, other means were sought. And so came into existence the metaphysical movements of mental-science healing and spiritual-science healing. And here you introduce into the world a new power: the power of the mind. The mind is a power over matter. The mind is a power over material conditions. With a directed activity of the mind you can overcome conditions of matter. This was so effectually proven that this means was later used for other purposes.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 7, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“Now then, what are we to do? First we had medicines to do our healing for us and they weren't entirely satisfactory. Then we had the power of the mind – that wasn't entirely satisfactory, not for long. And then it was believed that God, God, Spirit, could do the work. If only we could in some way reach God, or be reached by God, our problems would be overcome because God, being this great big power, had power to destroy all the other powers of earth.

In other words, the power of God was greater than the power of the devil. The difficulty was that the devil had easy access to us, but God was difficult of achievement, and so the devil had his way with us for a long, long time while we've tried to find some way of reaching God. It was a strange thing. We didn't have to reach the devil; he had a way of reaching us, but God didn't. We had to reach God.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 8, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“Now as long as an individual turns to God for the overcoming of material or mental problems, they will fail. As long as an individual has hope in God to destroy the sins of the flesh or the diseases of the body, they will fail. As long as an individual hopes that God will bring peace on earth and good will to men, they will fail. I wouldn't know how many centuries people have been going to church to pray to God for peace. I only know that in my short span we had World War I, II and the beginning of III, and countless days were spent in churches, not only by individuals but by whole nations, praying to God to bring peace on earth, and God's been a little bit slow about it. God is very slow about it because God has no power to bring peace on earth. That is something that can be done only by the individuals on earth. God cannot come into this room to establish peace among us. We can establish peace among ourselves. We do not have to war with each other. We do not have to sue each other. We do not have to have any form of arguments or disagreements—oh yes; we can have natural disagreements as to whether you like orchids better than roses—I wasn't thinking of that. We can disagree as to whether we like berry pie better than lemon pie. I wasn't thinking of that. I'm thinking of the fact that in this human world we are actually disagreeing in forceful ways, disagreeing on subjects of economy, politics, religion, race, creed, and at times even willing to commit murder in the name of Christ. Oh yes, 'if you don't join my religion, let's arm our brethren and go out and slay you - one way or another.' Now, there's no use praying to God about that. God's been prayed to for so many centuries—or what the world calls 'God' has been prayed

to—with no answer. There's more strife on earth than ever before because there are more people on earth and more races, more nations, more religions, more creeds. But, we can overcome war, disagreement, and it is to that end that we are here studying, bringing to light the spiritual laws that will make peace on earth possible for us first as individuals, and then for the world at large. ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 9, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“Now I'm returning to this subject of power. We find that the application of matter over matter, the power of matter over the power of matter, leads to an ultimate where you reach the utmost destructive power that matter has, and then find it equalizes itself by all having access to that same power. You come to mental power and you find yourself for awhile able to overcome, able to destroy, able to achieve, and then all of a sudden find that an immunity has been built against these mental powers. And when you turn to God or Spirit to overcome human problems, you find it doesn't work at all—not even from the beginning.”~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 10, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“To all of this there must be an answer because if there weren't a possibility of heaven on earth, we never would have had men like Lao-tse, Buddha, Shankara, Bodhisattva, Jesus, Paul, John, Plato, Socrates, Plotinus, and then later the mystics of Europe of the 12th to 17th centuries, and now the mystical teachings of the 20th century. None of these would have come into our experience had there not been the possibility of an actual heaven on earth—just as much of a heaven as we can have here in this atmosphere, in this room, on these grounds, in these islands. It's possible. The question is how. The secret that has been given to the world many times and lost each time is this: God is infinite, and beside God there is no power. Now as you start to live with this in mind, you change the entire complexion of your experience. Why? Because out here there appears to be persons detrimental or destructive to one's self or one's interest. Or there seems to be conditions or climates. In other words, there are persons or places, or things of a destructive nature—destructive to our health or destructive to our peace, destructive to the harmony of our affairs. And the spiritually illumined of all ages have learned that none of these is actually a power except insofar as you make them a power, accept them as a power, and then learn to fear them and fight them.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 11, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“The Master Christ Jesus made this clear in his teaching of ‘agreeing with thine adversary,’ not fighting the devil. He made it clear in his statement to the disciples when they boasted of their power over evil in his name. ‘Oh no. No, no, no, you have no power over evil. Just rejoice your names are writ in heaven.’ In other words, you have been admitted to the great revelation, the heavenly revelation, the spiritual revelation, that there is but one power, God. You have been admitted into the secret of God. Therefore, there is no evil subject unto you - not even by *My* name.

Why—what did the Master say to Pilate when Pilate threatened, "I have power to crucify you or set you free"? “Thou couldest have no power over me unless that power came from the Father in heaven.” Now here's the secret that is not known in the physical world. This is the secret that is not known in the mental world. This is the secret not known in the church world. This secret is only known in the mystical world: God is infinite power, and beside God there is no other power. Now the moment that you can be tempted to fight a person or a sin or a disease, you are engaged in battle that in the end will destroy you. Why? Because in and of itself it has no power, but you, yourself, are giving it the power against yourself.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 12, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“Now remember we are dealing not with a new religion, not with a new teaching, not with some magic formula that’s going to meet all of the problems of your existence. We are dealing with a universal truth that has been known from the beginning of time, has been introduced into human consciousness a half a dozen times, by great spiritually illumined souls, and each time has been lost. Whether or not it is lost again will depend probably on what degree the Grace of God has already touched human consciousness.

Personally, I don't believe it's ever going to be lost and I believe that the day is coming when the affairs of the world will all be settled through this understanding. I believe the day is coming when some one, or some group, will be called upon to establish that fact that God is the only power and God is good.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 13, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

Do you see how, how drastic the change must be in your individual consciousness, and mine, in order that we face life with the ability to look at evil people or germs, or sins, diseases, and to be able to say, "So what? Don't disturb me I'm resting. 'Thou couldst have no power' unless it came from the creative principle of the universe which is God."

Now our healing work in The Infinite Way is based on that as the basic principle. That, above all, is the state of consciousness that must be achieved by one before they are capable of going out and doing healing work.

That is why we have very few practitioners at this moment, the year of grace, 1955. I hope it will be different in 1956. But we have very few practitioners today because it is not a simple thing to give up all the generations of dualistic powers that you have held in thought—all of the ancestry that has given to you a fear of persons, places, things, circumstances and conditions. And so it is that it is not a simple thing for an individual to look at a disease and say "so what."

Remember saying "so what" won't heal it. Saying "so what" would only be the outward expression of an inner state of achieved consciousness. So don't say "so what" until something within prompts you to say "so what" because if merely saying it would do the work, then the hundred thousand people who have read some kind of Infinite Way literature would all be out doing healing work. It isn't that simple. The letter of truth merely prepares us for the actual

consciousness of truth.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 14, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“Now, our work in The Infinite Way acknowledges that since God is infinite and God is good, that God is the only power, that this truth realized would meet every situation of our experience. But The Infinite Way also realizes that because the human nature is built on the belief of two powers—not only from a material standpoint, but from a church standpoint, there isn't a church on earth that doesn't have two powers. They call it 'God' and 'devil.' Or in the metaphysical world, they'll call it the 'immortal' and the 'mortal.' "Oh look what mortal mind is doing to me!" "Oh, mortal mind is on the job today." As if mortal mind were a power or an entity any more than the devil were a power or an entity instead of being merely a belief, a universal belief, of a power apart from God.

Now, because these generations have built up in us a conviction of two powers, we now must train ourselves into the consciousness of one power. Just as if we were going to study music or mathematics, we would have to devote a certain length of time to the studying of the principles and the practice of the principles until we became proficient in it, so with this. In this we find that there are ways of developing our consciousness, of actually training ourselves, until we arrive at the spiritual demonstration of the consciousness of one power.” ~Joel

THE DAILY LESSON – July 15, 2010

From the 1955 Kailua Study Group Series - "One Power" by Joel S. Goldsmith:

“The message of The Infinite Way provides the method of study and of practice to attain that end. It is probably because I, myself, was so slow in coming to this realization that I believe everyone else is going to be slow in coming at it, and I do not declare anywhere that you can buy a book for two dollars and tomorrow start out healing the world. I acknowledge very freely that you must spend time and give effort to the attaining of “that mind which was also in Christ Jesus.”

“That mind which was also in Christ Jesus” is the mind that feared no powers external to its own being. ‘That mind which was in Christ Jesus’ had no fear of person, place, circumstance, or condition. That mind did not fear hunger. That mind did not fear disease. That mind did not fear death. That mind did not fear sin. It looked upon all of these as illusory experiences without power.

□□□To the sinner it said, “Neither do I condemn thee.”

□□□To the diseased it said, “Pick up your bed and walk.”

□□□To the dead it said, “Arise. Come forth.”

Why? Because ‘the mind that was in Christ Jesus’ does not acknowledge that death is a reality and that corpses cannot get up and walk. It does not acknowledge that disease is a power to hold one in bondage. It does not acknowledge that poverty is anything that can last with an individual or be, or be present, any longer than an individual wants to permit it.” ~Joel
