## The Daily Lesson – March 8, 2021

### “CHAPTER XXVII LIVING ABOVE THE PAIRS OF OPPOSITES

From the time of the second-chapter-of-Genesis creation, man has lived in a world of two powers, fluctuating between good and evil, and often experiencing more of evil than of good. As he gains the concept of one power, and one alone, and perceives that there is neither a good power nor an evil power, he is no longer fascinated by either the good or the evil of human experience, and he becomes less identified with sensations that arise from one or the other.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Matthew 4:1 & 8-11 (KJV)

1 Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

8 Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

9 And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

11 Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

Jesus was tempted with three ideas of ultimate power in this world, but in his high altitude of Christ Consciousness he could not be fooled. He Saw the presented appearance of power as an illusion, a con, or as no-power-at-all when he ordered

the antichrist to “get thee hence”. If this satan consciousness were a real power it would not yield, would it? You see, all cons require that we accept the premise of the con as real and we get to choose whether we are going to go along with it or not.

Jesus Knew, beyond a shadow of a doubt, that He was right.... That there can only be one Omnipotence. No matter how loud, convincing or masterful the concept artist is, what of it? There is only one answer, because there is only One Truth. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 9, 2021

“Man gradually learns to look upon evil without emotion, without attaching it to anyone, one might say almost without sympathy. He recognizes the nature of the appearance, and instead of accepting it as real, he accepts it as an appearance or as an illusory experience. This is not always easy to do, and it is far easier to see the illusory nature of an appearance of evil than it is to see the illusory nature or an appearance of good; but, easy or hard, the attitude must be attained and maintained that if the good is not of God, it will not be permanent, and therefore there is no use in rejoicing over it.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 7:24 (KJV)

24 Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.

John 8:3-10 (KJV)

3 And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,

4 They say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act.

5 Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou?

6 This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground, as though he heard them not.

7 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.

8 And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.

The voice of a tempter is a lie and lies cannot be heard when the Christ is Present. There is no need to react to movement of a shadow, because it is nothing but a shadow. Stand ye still with your feet planted firmly in Righteous Judgment. Practice this standing in Truth, and if you need help, ask and I will stand with you... ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 10, 2021

“It is obvious that this attitude takes a great deal of pleasure out of the human aspects of life, just as it takes a great deal of misery out of it, but it does replace those human emotions with an inner conviction that behind this visible scene there is a spiritual reality and at any moment it can come into full view” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Proverbs 3:5 (KJV)

5 Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

Romans 8:4-9 (to .) (KJV)

4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you.

Romans 8:14 (KJV)

14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

So we must develop and embrace an inner joy of conviction: to Love God with all our Heart and Soul and to Dwell Spirit to Spirit, Soul to Soul and to Lean on God to Lead us into Purity of Heart and Righteousness of Life. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 11, 2021

“When a call for help comes, our first and natural human reaction is the desire to change the evil appearance to a good one. If we are to succeed in spiritual living, however, we must very quickly bring to conscious awareness the truth that the object of a spiritual ministry is not to change disease into health, for health is only one of those temporary conditions that become disease tomorrow, next week, or next year, and not to decry the evil and try to bring about the good; but rather to turn away from the appearance and keep our gaze on the Middle Path, realizing that right where there is an appearance of either good or evil, there is spiritual reality.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 11:5-10 (KJV)

5 Now Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus.

6 When he had heard therefore that he was sick, he abode two days still in the same place where he was.

7 Then after that saith he to his disciples, Let us go into Judaea again.

8 His disciples say unto him, Master, the Jews of late sought to stone thee; and goest thou thither again?

9 Jesus answered, Are there not twelve hours in the day? If any man walk in the day, he stumbleth not, because he seeth the light of this world.

10 But if a man walk in the night, he stumbleth, because there is no light in him.

When the news of Jesus' friend arrived, do you suppose that Jesus first thought to do something about it? I don't know, but I do know he stopped in his tracks for two days to be still. When we are presented with an appearance - Be still, God is Present right now, right where you are. There is no need to go somewhere to do God's Work – do not proceed until The Way for you is Illumined and you are Led. “I Am a lamp unto thy feet.” ~Al Denninger

John 11:5-10 (KJV)

14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead.

15 And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him.

The distraction would have been great. Everybody wanted Jesus to go and fix Lazarus. It is better to stay, be still and unplug from the appearances. When I am Ready, I will go as the Christ. ~Al Denninger

John 11:21-25 (KJV)

21 Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.

22 But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee.

23 Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

In the human scene, there is life and there is death, and always a desire to correct an appearance of error. In the Presence of Christ, there is only the Way, the Truth and the Life, and therefore, nothing to correct and no waiting for some future date for the Fullness of God. Today I will be with you in paradise. The I that I Am is the Resurrection, the Awareness of Life Everlasting, or Spiritual Reality, that Is and was, and ever will Be. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 12, 2021

“An evil appearance of today can change into a good appearance tomorrow, and, as we so well know, every good appearance can soon be turned into an evil one: the peace on earth one day is only a momentary pause before another war; perfect health today is only a temporary condition which germs or the calendar can change. In the human picture we are on a merry-go-round that goes round and round and round; in the human picture we sway like a pendulum between sickness and health, between lack and abundance, between war and peace, going back and forth, but never getting anywhere.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Matthew 6:19-21 (KJV)

19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!

24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

25 Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life,

James 1:17 (KJV)

17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Appearances in this-world have opposites, take no thought of them. Light from Above has no opposite. There is no such thing as darkness – there is nothing – just an absence of Illumination. Light in its Pure form has no variableness, it is like the Sun at noon that casts no shadow turning. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 13, 2021

“But the pairs of opposites do not operate in *My* kingdom: *My* kingdom is a spiritual kingdom in which everything is intact; *My* kingdom is under the direction, protection, maintenance, and sustenance of its divine Principle, God. In *My* kingdom there is no darkness. That statement would seem to imply that darkness is evil, but by the time we reach the Third Degree, we have risen to the spiritual stature of the Psalmist who said that ‘the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.’” ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 18:36 (to :) (KJV)

36 Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world:

Psalms 139:7-12 (KJV)

7 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?

8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there.

9 If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;

10 Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.

11 If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me.

12 Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.

My Kingdom is the Infinite Invisible Creation of God. God is Present and Complete wherever you are, no matter what, and no matter when... No matter what you think, and no matter where you look. In the valley of the shadow of death, on your happiest day, on the lightest day or the darkest night, I Am with you always. ~Al Denninger



## The Daily Lesson – March 14, 2021

“Darkness and light are the same. In the eyes of God there is no difference between them. In the spiritual kingdom there is neither light nor darkness in any physical sense: there is only Spirit, a Light which has no similarity whatsoever to what we know as light.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 4:24 (KJV)

24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

I Corinthians 2:9-14 (KJV)

9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Man's thought can have varying and even opposite opinions, which has nothing to do with Spiritual Discernment or Revelations of Truth. Elevate your focus. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 15, 2021

“Light in the spiritual sense is the illumined consciousness, not illumined by a light but illumined by wisdom. ‘Whereas I was blind, now I See’ does not refer to blindness or to an absence of sight. It is the figurative way of stating that whereas before we were in ignorance now we have attained wisdom. Ignorance is frequently referred to as darkness, and wisdom as light, but there is no actual darkness or light about them.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 9:24-27 & 39-41 (KJV)

24 Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: we know that this man is a sinner.

25 He answered and said, Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.

26 Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?

27 He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear it again? will ye also be his disciples?

39 And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

40 And some of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also?

41 Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.

The Pharisees were living only in their sense of human law, veiled in this-world’s observation and not looking beyond words and thoughts to See the Present Christ right there in front of them. The healed man was transformed into an enlightened believer and couldn’t understand why the Pharisees could not get past the literal and so be Christ’s disciple Led by the Spiritual inspiration opened up by the healing. Their only sin was to hold on to their sense of separation from God. When we are struck with the internal Spiritual lesson and meaning of Eternal Light there is no more veil of separation. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 16, 2021

“It requires months, sometimes years, of spiritual experience before we can realize that in *My kingdom* light and darkness are the same, and that we are not trying to change darkness into light, or to get rid of darkness in order to get light. Darkness and light are one. Grasping that concept is a big leap for anyone, but for the person ignorant of spiritual wisdom and untrained in metaphysics and mysticism, it is an even greater leap—almost an impossible one—to grasp the idea that disease and health are one. They are really just opposite ends of the same stick. When we can state with conviction, ‘As far as I am concerned, darkness and light are one. I am not seeking to get rid of one to get the other: I am seeking only to realize spiritual wisdom, spiritual truth, and the divine Presence,’ then we shall begin to perceive the spiritual nature of this universe.”

Leviiticus 27:33 (KJV)

33 He shall not search whether it be good or bad, neither shall he change it: and if he change it at all, then both it and the change thereof shall be holy; it shall not be redeemed.

Matthew 6:31-34 (KJV)

31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

There is only One health, One supply, One Harmony, One Light, One Omnipresence - and it is God's. Can we find anything else than God in My Kingdom? You can't change something that does not exist, right? Seek only the Awareness of God and you will find you are Included in His Allness. Take no other thought. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 17, 2021

“It is when we are trying to get rid of something, or to get something, that we have left the spiritual universe for the universe of human concepts. Neither disease nor health has any part in the spiritual life: all that exists in the spiritual life is God, Spirit infinitely and eternally manifested as individual incorporeal being.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 4:20-24 (KJV)

20 Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.

21 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.

22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Jesus gave the greatest Gift of the Living Water of Everlasting Life to the Samaritan woman at Jacob's well. He announced to the world right then and there, what his teaching would be: to take no thought for the things of this-world and seek ye first the Kingdom of God in Spirit and in Truth and not by asking for things and corrections. The Father already Knoweth the things we have need of, because God is our Life, our Health, our Harmony and Abundance.... And so, we worship and practice Spirit to Spirit, Soul to Soul to this day. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 18, 2021

“Incorporeal being cannot be known through the senses of sight, hearing, taste, touch, or smell: it can be experienced only in our consciousness, but once that experience comes to us we shall really understand that darkness and light are one. And what is that one? Mortal illusion, *maya*, appearance. Whatever we are aware of through the senses—sickness and poverty today, or health and wealth tomorrow—is an illusion. We are not beholding reality until, through our spiritual awareness, we behold incorporeal spiritual being.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

(Here's the part that Paul told us we couldn't understand in the flesh – only in Spiritual Discernment) We don't do anything. We of our own selves can do nothing... We must stand stock still and Let the Spirit do the Dwelling, the Living and the Be-ing. The Life of our Be-ing is not ours but His. We Let God do the praying. We Love God with all our Heart and Consciousness and Let God do the Loving our neighbors as ourselves – all of it. We are God's individual expression, Living His Life – we are not an appearance of a separate life living God's desire. Our every activity and action is His. What we do is we open out a way for His Imprisoned splendor to escape our grasp on it and do His Work. We become the current Instrument of Love Loving, right here and now. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 19, 2021

“When we can look out upon this human world and ask, ‘What has it profited the world all its wars?’ and receive the answer, ‘Nothing,’ we are beginning to reach the goal. Hand in hand with this question must come a second one, ‘What has it profited the world all the days in which there has been no war?’ and this, too must receive the answer, ‘Nothing.’ Spiritually, it is not war or peace we are seeking: it is the government of God, spiritual government divine government. And where does this take place? In our consciousness. That is where it must be realized.”

1 Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.

10 Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee?

11 Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above:

31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;

32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Be Jesus’ disciple... Seek ye only the Truth of the Kingdom of God – for there is no other Government – no other power. Let the Consciousness of Christ fill you and govern your Heart. Why? Because nothing else is Real. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – March 20, 2021

“No matter how many solutions are offered today to the problems of the world, tomorrow they will break out in new and more serious forms. The end of all this shifting back and forth will come only when we perceive the nature of spiritual power, and realize that spiritual power has nothing to do with good conditions today or evil conditions tomorrow. Rather does it have to do with our understanding that we are not seeking to change the conditions of matter but to realize the omnipresence of Spirit, that we are not seeking to turn sickness into health or war into peace: we are seeking the government of God, the revelation and the realization of God as our consciousness.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Matthew 6:31-33 (KJV)

31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles [not yet enlightened individuals] seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

*When we are Dwelling in the Kingdom of God we are Included in the Government of God – all that is needed to get there is the Awareness of the Truth of Spiritual Power.... There is no struggle, no pleading in thought, no declarations to make....and no cross to bear.... There is no error, there is nothing to correct, nothing to heal, nothing to add, think about, or forgive....*

*Illumination dissolves all material ties... There is no longer a concept of Spirit.... There is only Spirit Being Its Harmonious Self.... Why? Because, I Am with you now, and forever..... This is God's Promise written in the letter of the Word that we find in Scripture, and in the Living Word that is Felt beyond thought. Omnipresence Is. ~al.within*

## The Daily Lesson – March 21, 2021

“This changes our whole mode of life. Under our old way of living, the best that we could hope for was to turn some evil condition into a good one or some negative condition into a positive one, and even though there was the ever-present fear that it would not be permanent, we were always striving for those temporary moments of health, of peace, or of harmony.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

I Corinthians 15:49-52 & 58 (KJV)

49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

*And so, I stand steadfast and unmovable, faithfully focused on The Father's Business... There is a Peace that passeth understanding that Comes with the Divine Spark of Truth – there is a Smile within that can't be described.... His Love has changed me... ## The Daily Lesson – March 22, 2021

“The revelation and understanding of one power helps us to arrive at the consciousness where we do not seek to change the negative to the positive. In the realization of one power, we not only stop seeking some material power with which to meet our need, but we stop seeking a spiritual power.

Since there is but one power, then, there is nothing on, against, or for which to use this power. What in essence does this really mean? What does it mean to reach a point in consciousness where we relinquish all thought of using God as a power? Have we not thus really released God from responsibility? “God is forever about His business. God is the creative, maintaining, and sustaining influence of the spiritual universe. God governs His universe by Grace, and this not tomorrow or next week. The divine Grace that has been in operation from everlasting to everlasting will continue from everlasting to everlasting without our bribing or trying to influence God, without our praying, pleading, or doing anything else to persuade God to do His own work. God is, and this includes the truth that God is forever about the business of being God.” ~Joel S Goldsmith
