The Daily Lesson – April 15, 2022

“CHAPTER THREE

GOD REVEALING THE INFINITY OF BEING

The words of wise men are heard in quiet more than the cry of him that ruleth among fools. Ecclesiastes 9:17

We are surrounded at all times by what Scripture calls ‘angels’ which hover about us always. Within us are those divine ideas or spiritual impulses which guide, lead, and direct us, even though as human beings we are not aware of them. As human beings, brought up with the ordinary church experience or with no church at all, we are not aware of the fact that we are constantly under divine government, divine guidance. In reality we are under the law of the Spirit of God, and under the spirit of the law of God. In practice, we walk around like the Prodigal, thinking, ‘I, of mine own self, am something and I am going out into the world to make a name for myself, to earn a living for myself, and to become something great of and by myself.’ Thereby, we set up a counterfeit identity and develop concern about the health, wealth, success, and contacts of this counterfeit identity. Yet, all the time, even though probably we have never thought of it, we have been completely surrounded by an atmosphere of love and completely enveloped in divine Being. As a matter of fact, we are divine Being. We are the Father-consciousness Itself, but we have walked about in the world, believing that consciousness to be something small, finite, insignificant, and unimportant.” Joel S Goldsmith

“The purpose of this ministry is to bring us back to the Father's house, back to a consciousness of the presence and power of God. The Daily Lesson – April 17, 2022

“Synonyms for God

For a moment, let us consider the synonyms for God, taking just a few with which we are familiar. We know God as infinite being, and therefore, we take each of the synonyms for God as representing the allness and wholeness of God. We do not separate God into synonyms and then say, ‘This synonym represents one quality or activity of God, and this synonym represents another quality or activity.’ We understand that every synonym represents the allness of God, although we may use a certain synonym in order to emphasize some particular quality or activity.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Isaiah 44:6-8 (KJV)

6 Thus saith the Lord the King of Israel, and his redeemer the Lord of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.

7 And who, as I, shall call, and shall declare it, and set it in order for me, since I appointed the ancient people? and the things that are coming, and shall come, let them shew unto them.

8 Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; I know not any.

The Daily Lesson – April 18, 2022

“Let me illustrate this. God is infinite; therefore, God is immortality or eternal life. Since that is true, eternal life must be as infinite as God, and must include the activities and properties of incorporeal Spirit, divine love, and eternal substance. God is infinite; God is infinite being; God is Spirit; God is the substance of the universe. Therefore, since God is infinite, Spirit and substance must be infinite, and incorporeal Spirit embraces, includes, and externalizes all the activity of life, truth, love, Soul, principle, law, together with all the other synonyms for God which are found in Scripture.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 19, 2022

“Why, then, do we divide the word God into synonyms and use them interchangeably? It is for the same reason and in the same way that you may speak of my being a man, a husband, a father, a friend, a practitioner, a teacher, a lecturer, and a writer. But each one of these includes all the others. When you speak of me, for instance, as a teacher, you do so to emphasize one particular phase of my work, but this does not mean that you are not aware of my being all the other things, too. In the same way, when I think of you as a friend or as a student, I also think of you as a man, a woman, a mother, or a father. At least, in the back of my mind, I know that you are all those things, too. I cannot separate the ‘you’ of you as a student from the ‘you’ of you as a parent, husband, wife, or friend.” Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 20, 2022

“When we think of healing and of healing work, we turn to the word of God to bring out the divine allness of individual being. We turn to God to bring out—to disclose, to reveal, to unfold, to manifest—the allness of God, the allness of divine Being as your individual being. We do not want to bring out the harmony of your being in one area and lose sight of it in other areas, but rather, we bring out the allness of the divine Being as your individual being. We do this because we are not yet at that level of consciousness which does not occasionally require what we call treatment, and for that reason we make use of the synonyms for God.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 21, 2022

“Now we acknowledge that there are varying states and stages of consciousness. One person, coming into a metaphysical teaching, may come in on the level of a deeply religious consciousness. He comes into the fullness of understanding through first entertaining a clear idea of love, of God, of the Christ, of the Master, and of his disciples. Devotional religious love may predominate in his approach to the spiritual path.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

James 1:22-26 (KJV)

22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:

While deep devotion to a natural man's religion and his wisdom are words on the path to discernment, it is not to the level of actual Spiritual Discernment—comparing Spirit with Spirit and Soul to Soul. *I don't have an interest in what man thinks and does in man's idea of religion, it just slows me down... I am interested in Seeing what God Sees, and Knowing what God Knows.... And Resting in It, in Peace and Love, and in Holy Communion... Opening up an Understanding that passeth understanding... And in turn, Being God's Instrument shining a Light on the Truth... Stay on Your Path ~Al Denninger*

The Daily Lesson – April 22, 2022

“But there are others to whom this would be unintelligible. These students understand God to be infinite intelligence; they are not interested in the devotional approach to God, and, oftentimes, not even in the word God. I have heard metaphysicians say, ‘Forget that word God. You use it too much.’ In the same way, another one of my friends was opposed to the term the Christ, and said, ‘Can’t you think of something else for the Christ? Can’t you say ‘the truth’ or ‘the law’? I answered that I could, but that the Christ to me was something so personal, so still, and so sweet, that I would not want to give up that term.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Psalms 119:33-37 (KJV)

The Daily Lesson – April 23, 2022

“To some students, divine Love might mean a great deal. Still another person might come in on the level of mind, and, in that case, his trend or his prayer would be more along the lines of realizing mind, manifest as idea, manifest as activity, manifest even as law. There are those who can only understand God as law, and they are very rigid about the idea that God is law.

It is not for us to judge as to whether anyone is ‘right’ or ‘wrong.’ These various approaches to metaphysical work are merely degrees or different states of consciousness, and each one of us, according to his own background, environment, or pre-existence sees this work in a different light. One comes through devotion, one through mind, and one through principle. But if we are progressing, if we are understanding more and more of this work, we are coming to that place in consciousness where no treatment is ever necessary, and in that state we look out upon the world, beholding the perfection which underlies all appearances. Then we are not touched by any appearance. We know the appearance to be unreality, a false sense of the real, and we do not give a treatment. Yet no matter how far we progress in this work, there are times when we are called upon to think in terms of what the world might call a treatment, and that is where the use of the synonyms for God comes in.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Individual expression does not mean separation from God—rather, it means that there is One Omniscient Consciousness Infinitely Expressed As.... Always Love as Christ has Loved us. ~Al Denninger

The Daily Lesson – April 24, 2022

“In treatment in its highest sense, we turn to the principle: We turn to God. We touch and make contact with that, and all of a sudden, we feel the divine life-energy flowing through. That is all there is to treatment. Then, after we have made the contact, usually word comes that the patient is healed or improved. If he is not completely healed, we make the contact again, and again. Ultimately, he, himself, realizes his freedom and says: ‘Now I am healed, and I know it.’” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 25, 2022

“If we have difficulty in establishing that contact, if our own thought is not sufficiently clear to carry us immediately to the throne of God, then these synonyms serve a wonderful purpose. Let us suppose that we are confronted with a condition of illness where there seems to be a danger to life. Life is not in danger. That is only the appearance, for Life is never in danger. So, in turning to God as life, we think of life as immortality and eternity. We think of life as having no beginning and no ending. We see Life as the life of the universe, the life and the law, not only of individual man and woman, but of all that is appearing as the animal, vegetable, and mineral world. We see God as the life of the universe. We allow our thought to dwell on this idea of life eternal, life immortal, and we let any thoughts, that come to us along this line unfold. When that has gone on for a while, and we finally feel we have come to an end of this contemplation, we just keep the listening ear open until we feel the truth. Then we can say, ‘Thank you, Father, it is done.’” ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 14:6 (to :) (KJV)

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life:

I can of mine own self do nothing... I never could, Father, I am Your Life, Your Spirit is within Me Living Now, because You put It there... There is only One Life, Ever-present, without beginning or end—so It can never be in danger or in need of correction.... Your Life is Infinite, and is Present as an unlimited number of individual Expressions—each singing the Words “I Am” with Joy and Peace and in Harmony... Spiritual Life is beyond the words and thoughts of the carnal man... .. The form that appears as my life is merely a temporary vessel. It is Your Creation designed to perform Your Will... The True Life is within, invisible, and in Your Words, is created in Your Image and Likeness, truly Good and with Dominion, not weakness or lack.... I surrender with deep gratitude and love... .. --I Know--... .. Speak Lord, thy servant is Listening... ~al.within

The Daily Lesson – April 26, 2022

“Another case may present itself to us, and this time it may be something with the appearance of paralysis, of inaction or overaction. In such a case, we may quickly think of mind as the instrument of God:

Mind is the source and seat of all action. Mind, as the instrument of God is the law unto all manifestation, unto all creation. Infinite Intelligence governs, maintains, and sustains its ideas. Body, as idea, is a formation of mind, just as the reality underlying all formation is right idea. Without mind, there is no idea. Without idea, there is no mind, because there could not be mind without activity, and the activity of mind is idea. There cannot be paralyzed mind, or paralyzed idea. There can be only harmonious activity in mind, which is the instrument of infinite Intelligence and which expresses infinite activity.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 27, 2022

“In spiritual healing, always remember this: Never approach the healing work from the standpoint of disease or from the standpoint of the patient. Leave your patient out of it entirely. The moment a claim is presented as person or condition, drop it from your mind, then and there, and go to that word God. Drop all sense of man, of sin, of disease, of lack and limitation. If you find yourself struggling with these errors, trying to improve or change them, you will not bring about healing. Go to that word God as quickly as you can. Then, if you like, jump from God to one of the synonyms, and in that way work out from God.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

We must drop the idea that there is an error to somehow correct in God's Kingdom. Be still, Freedom and Harmony is realized in the Spiritual Discernment that passeth the natural mans' understanding. "Thy will be done in earth as it is in Heaven". Thy Will is Done. ~Al Denninger

The Daily Lesson – April 28, 2022

“Love Is the Basis of All Relationships

It is the same in any problem of human relationships. It may be the relationship between employer and employee, between husband and wife, between parent and child. But actually, in each and every situation, what we are dealing with is God. In all cases of human relationships, love is the only relationship there is, because God is love. Did you ever stop to think that there would be no relationships at all between human beings, if there were not love to cement that relationship? Whether the relationship is between parent and child, or whether it is between human beings and birds, beasts, or plants makes no difference. Love is the basis of all relationships.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 29, 2022

“Therefore, if the claim is that of a discordant relationship between people, let us turn immediately to the word God, and then quickly go from there to divine Love, emanating as an aura. Love is a permeating substance, a penetrating substance. Love is a cement, a uniting influence. Then come words like ‘unity,’ ‘oneness,’ ‘at-one-ment’—all properties of this divine Love.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 30, 2022

“Do you see that in thinking along these lines we have never thought about the persons involved, about the human beings in the picture and their worried or disturbed relationships? All we have thought about is Love and Its properties, Love and Its qualities, Love and Its influence, Love and Its omnipresence. By the time we have finished thinking about Love, the telephone should be ringing with someone at the other end telling us that there has been a reuniting.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – May 1, 2022

“These examples show us the reason for using synonyms for God. We are seeking merely to find the word that most closely fits the situation as it is presented to us in the human picture. Yet, all the time we are talking about Love, let us remember that Love is also divine intelligence, Love is also substance.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – May 2, 2022

“When we think of love, we cannot help going back to the ministry of the Master: ‘My peace I give unto you . . . Love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.’ You will never stray far from the Christ while you are dealing with love, and you will never stray far from ‘Peace be still,’ while you are living with that word ‘love.’ In the same way, you will never get very far into sin, disease, or death, while your thought is being permeated with the consciousness of life eternal. “I do not want to dwell too much on modes and methods of treatment, because I do not believe them to be too necessary at our stage of development. Yet I do recognize that in some small degree, treatment always will be necessary. We cannot completely overlook it. Therefore, in all my writings you will find some reference to treatment. These are enough to keep you on the path, and yet not allow you to sit upon a cloud and remain there without some resting place for your feet.

Now I want to explain one reason why we never treat a person, why we never give a treatment to any person. If anything in my writings has led to the belief that I would ever give a treatment to any person, let me correct that concept now. I have been in this work for twenty-eight years, and never have I given a treatment to anyone. Sometimes people say, ‘I got your treatment, and it was beautiful.’ That is impossible. I have never given a treatment to anyone, and I have never directed my thought to a person. I have never addressed the individual consciousness of any person. Never have I said, ‘You are spiritual; you are perfect; you are God’s child.’ Never have I allowed the name of a patient to come into my thought while I was ‘treating.’ Never have I allowed the face, or thought, or outline of any face or body, to come into my treatment.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Did he say anything about food other than to bless it? Was there any kind of "treatment"? The answer to all of these is no.

Did he follow his own instructions for prayer that he gave earlier on the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 6:5-8)? Yes. Jesus Knew God is Omniscient and already Knows the things needed. He didn't need to give a sermon to show His personal importance or speak about the peoples' personal need or even to teach a lesson about God's Infinite Abundance. He didn't take up a collection to buy food. The Christ Looked Up, and in His Secret Place of the Most High, He Acknowledged God, blessed the Loaves and Fishes and passed out Spiritual Supply manifest as all the Loaves and Fishes that were needed. All did eat and were filled, with an abundance left over and everyone witnessed God's Supply in a Spiritual and in a tangible way. I am sure that if there would have been ten thousand mouths to feed the result would have been the same. Jesus did not treat a lack – He Knew the Truth and Acted in the Truth. ~Al Denninger

The Daily Lesson – June 6, 2022

“All healing is in the world of belief. All takes place in the Adam—dream. God knows nothing about it, because in the entire kingdom of God there never was a sin, a disease, or a death. And this comes through your conscious communion with God, which is the purpose of our work.
