## The Daily Lesson – February 15, 2023

“Nothing is ever what it appears to be in the human picture. We often think that we are doing something for a normal, natural, human reason and, later on, find that this was not at all the real purpose of what we did. The human reason is sometimes only the decoy that sends us on the real mission, and the true purpose was perhaps not apparent to us at all.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The reasoning mind can never accept the Truth of Righteous Judgment. It seems too fantastic for limited this-world belief to accept. The Christ, on the other hand, cannot see the limitations of physical appearances. The Christ says, “why can’t he walk?”, or better yet, “just walk!” ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – February 16, 2023

“We should know by now that as human beings, we are only a transparency for the Divine. Actually, our purpose in studying spiritual wisdom is to find out, through meditation, what the spiritual plan is, and what our part in it is. As we make our contact, we become the visible transparency for the inner, divine, spiritual plan. Then, God, infinite Spirit, is able to use us and to manifest Itself as our individual being, working out Its plan on what we humanly call the earth.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

## The Daily Lesson – February 17, 2023

“It is the earth, but it is more than just the earth: It is both heaven and earth. Heaven and earth are not two different and separate places, except in the human sense of time and place. Reality knows no such thing as ‘time,’ no such thing as ‘place.’ Time is really now; place is here. Whether or not this earth is a hell or a heaven is dependent upon your view of it, because where some find heaven, others find hell. Some of us find enjoyment in many places right here on earth; others find suffering in the very same places. It is all in the point of view, in the attitude of the individual. Heaven is not a place, and hell is not a place. They are states of consciousness, here and now.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

## The Daily Lesson – February 18, 2023

“There is only one way to find your heaven on earth, and that is through inner contact with God. Rest assured that all that humanhood is, is a sense of separation from God. All that divine being is, is conscious oneness with God. In the purely personal, almost mechanical process of getting up in the morning, going out to your daily work, and then going back to bed again at night, you are a human being, subject to all the experiences of humanhood, which include temptation, disease, lack, worry, and danger. But, in making contact with God so that you feel it, so that you actually catch that sense of awareness, you let your humanhood become the transparency through which the Divinity of you is shining. ## The Daily Lesson – February 22, 2023

### *“Contact with God*

The purpose of meditation is not to think a lot of thoughts and declare truths. Its real object is direct contact with God. No one but a child would play with an instrument as useful as the telephone. We adults pick it up for the specific purpose of making contact with someone, somewhere. In this work, too, we have a specific contact to make—a specific number to reach, G-o-d! There is no way to achieve the guidance and direction of God except by tuning in and listening for, and ultimately hearing the ‘still small voice,’ which does not necessarily mean hearing audibly, although it sometimes comes that way.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

## The Daily Lesson – February 23, 2023

“We mean receiving the sense, awareness, or feeling of that Presence. Why make statements such as, ‘God is directing and protecting me’ and continue to experience accidents, sin, disease, and death? The statement, ‘God is with me’ is no insurance policy. Not all the affirmations in the world that ‘God is with me,’ or ‘God is presence; God is power; God is my life,’ can save us, because these statements are merely steps on the way. The only time that we, actually, know that God is omnipresent and omnipotent and omniscient—on the job—is when we have made the contact, and know that we have made it, or at least, have opened our consciousness to make it. There are times when we open our consciousness and do not receive a direct answer or have the feeling that we have succeeded in making the contact. But that is not too important. The important thing is to have opened consciousness to the contact, to have sat down even for a moment and to have said, ‘Father, here I am. Be with me.’ ~Joel S Goldsmith

I Samuel 3:1-10

God is always Broadcasting His Love to us, that is what Omnipresence does. But we must make the actual step to tune in and Listen. We must also answer the call as Eli directed Samuel – with an attitude of speak Lord, thy servant Heareth. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – February 24, 2023

“In this way we have opened our consciousness to the inflow. We have fulfilled Scripture: ‘Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee . . . Lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him.’ We can all remember to stop to listen, while we go about our housekeeping, buying, or business. ‘Lean not unto thine own understanding’. Do not lean even on your own hearing ability, or on trying to understand rationally the meaning of what you hear or read. Lean on your spiritual understanding and spiritual wisdom, on that mind that was in Christ Jesus, which was and is your mind. Lean on that to interpret to you what you read and what you hear.” Joel S Goldsmith

“Take any one of these wonderful quotations that we have been reading in the Bible, and not obeying. ‘The Lord will perfect that which concerneth me.’ Does He? Has He? Look over your human life and see whether He really has made all that concerns you perfect. In most cases, you will find that He has not, and the reason He has not is because you have not opened your consciousness to let Him in. God is omnipotence, certainly. But what good is that to you, unless *you* open your consciousness specifically and make yourself a transparency for It, or for Him, to enter in?” ~Joel S Goldsmith

And so we must stop coasting, seek ye first the Kingdom, practice and Abide. ~Al Denninger

## The Daily Lesson – February 26, 2023

“If you could follow scriptural history about the time of Jesus, you would know how many hundreds of thousands of people never were aware of the birth of the Christ, never acknowledged it, or even wondered if there weren't a fire somewhere! No, they did not even smell the ‘smoke.’ The birth of the Christ could have raised the entire Hebrew people up into the highest state of spiritual realization. But how many Hebrews received or accepted the Christ? So few that another religion developed, based entirely upon the one who had been rejected of his own people. ‘He came unto his own, and his own received him not.’” ~Joel S Goldsmith

It is true, ‘Before Abraham was, I am,’ and ‘I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.’ With whom? Only with those who open their consciousness to It! Only with those who become receptive, those who learn to listen for the ‘still small voice.’” ~Joel S Goldsmith

## The Daily Lesson – February 28, 2023

### *“Dedication*

The experience of entertaining the Christ, of living by the Christ, comes only to those who actually make the contact, who actually feel the divine Presence, and who know consciously that It is moving them about from here to there. In our humanhood and by our human actions we never know the real purpose behind those actions. If we are in tune with the Infinite, the Divine has a way of using us to Its purpose—not to glorify us or to show forth what good demonstrators of truth we are, not to show how great a practice, or income, or position, we can attain. Its purpose has nothing to do with that. Its use of us must, in some way, show forth God's works. Let God's plan be revealed in you, but never have your heart so set on a demonstration that you are not equally satisfied to see it turn out otherwise—‘not my will, but thine, be done.’ ~Joel S Goldsmith

“Do you not see the necessity for keeping your consciousness open to God's direction? Otherwise, we would be going along in the same old path we have been on for years and years. Why was it that we changed? We didn't. What happened was that, in some measure, our consciousness was opened to divine direction, probably because we were willing to set aside stated periods every day and every night for tuning in, for opening consciousness, for saying, ‘Father, walk in and take over.’ We were preparing for that dedication and consecration which would enable us to say, truly, ‘I live, yet not I, but Christ liveth in me.’ Then, every day we rededicate ourselves: ‘Father, here I am. My mind, my Soul, my body—all are yours. You take them. You take over.’ Unless we do dedicate and consecrate ourselves, we shall never live more than a human existence which begins at birth and ends in the grave. If we do adopt and open consciousness to this method of living, we soon shall find that we are not living a human life after all. Truth, Life, Soul, Intelligence—all really are God; yes, even the body is the temple of the living God. We shall find, then, that God is using all there is of us to Its purpose.” ~Joel S Goldsmith
