The Daily Lesson – March 22, 2023

“CHAPTER ELEVEN

The Daily Lesson – March 23, 2023

“Three times or more, Jesus fed the multitudes. He fed four thousand, five thousand, seven thousand. Today we would call that an act of great philanthropy. Not only did he feed the multitudes, but he healed them and taught the truth to those who could hear. But after he had fed the multitudes on one side of the sea, he felt a heavy sense within himself- a sense that his message had not reached his people, a sense of discouragement in the realization that they had failed to catch the vision. We are told that he left them and went across the lake, but even there the multitudes followed him. Probably they followed him because they were hungry again and wanted more loaves and fishes. He must have recognized that loaves and fishes were all they wanted because he turned and rebuked them: ‘You are here because you received the loaves and fishes yesterday, and now you have come back for more of them. Why is it that you did not see the miracle? Why is it that you did not see the principle that produced those loaves and fishes, so that by now some of you could have been producing and multiplying loaves and fishes on your own, and not coming back to me to be fed?’”

We can't See the Principle of Truth if we are looking for physical improvements in this-world. The Source and the Supply are Infinite—there is no pause when an individual expression of God, such as Jesus, or John, or Paul, or Joel are no longer visible. If you are truly grateful take up the Robe and Follow Christ. Is it more important to be fed in this-world—or be Fed in Spirit, by Spirit? ~Al Denninger

The Daily Lesson – March 24, 2023

“How often he healed the multitudes—how often he healed individuals—and how little healing power any of those people manifested themselves! How great was his sorrow when he said, ‘Jerusalem, Jerusalem, I would love to tell you and show you, but you cannot accept it.’ Those people whom he had healed and had supplied were grateful; they were grateful for the loaves and fishes. But that was not the type of gratitude the Master was seeking. The Master was seeking gratitude for a principle that he was showing forth and which they were not able to grasp. Their whole thought was on the *effect*, and not on the *cause*. The tragedy of the entire mission of Jesus was that so many were grateful for the effects, and so few caught the vision of the cause—so few were able to go out and do likewise. In the ministry of the Master, there is a principle shown forth. It is a principle of living, a principle of healing, a principle of supply. As you read the New Testament, see if you cannot discern the principle he was trying to set forth and also notice that the people he helped saw only the effect of that principle.”

The Daily Lesson – March 25, 2023

“Had Jesus been merely a wonder worker, had he desired merely to set himself up as a great man, a great teacher, a great healer, or a great supplier, he would not have had to undergo the Crucifixion. There would have been no necessity for it. He would have set up a clinic and branch clinics for healing people, and super-markets for supplying them, and just continued multiplying the goods in the markets, letting people come, partake, and be grateful. There would have been a deep gratitude in the hearts of those people, because they would no longer have had to till the soil, or operate meat markets, fish markets, and vegetable markets. How easy life would have been! All that would have been necessary would have been to go to the store where Jesus was multiplying loaves and fishes. Or how easy it would have been to go to the clinics where his disciples would have established themselves and would be saying: ‘Come on in and be healed! Without money and without price! Well, pay a little mite if you like, a little love-offering, but come and get rid of all your diseases. Well do it for you.’ Oh, the people would have been so grateful!” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – March 26, 2023

“Be Grateful for the Principle

Yet Jesus never attempted that type of demonstration. Only three or four times in his whole ministry did he multiply loaves and fishes. Only a few times did he heal the multitudes. If you had noticed Jesus walking up and down by the shores of Galilee, you would not have found him looking around for sick people to heal. Usually, he passed right by them, but they ran after him, calling out, ‘Oh, Master, Master! Heal me!’ Yes, his people were grateful for the loaves and fishes and would have continued to feel that sense of gratitude had he kept on giving them effects, effects, and more effects. But that sense of gratitude—a gratitude for effects—was not the type of gratitude for which he was looking. He was looking for the gratitude of those who could discern the principle behind the miracle. It is that same type of gratitude that we in this work are looking for today. It is not the gratitude that causes people to come and say, ‘Oh, that was a beautiful healing! Here is a check.’ We much prefer to hear: ‘That was a beautiful healing! How was it accomplished? What was the principle behind it? Teach me the principle.’” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – March 27, 2023

“In this work, it is a very easy thing to arouse gratitude in the hearts of people. We hear again and again: ‘Your writing is so inspiring. You bring out such spiritual stories and incidents. You draw on such a world of scriptural history and literature, and other inspirational, philosophical, and metaphysical literature!’ It is not a difficult thing to arouse people to a state of gratitude. But the real teacher is not seeking that type of gratitude. It is well enough that people feel a gratitude for the message, but the real gratitude which makes the spiritual teacher rejoice is that which comes from those who are catching the vision and saying: ‘Thank you, I saw the Christ. Thank you, I have experienced the very presence of God, and now I can go out and do likewise, even if it is only in a measure!’” ~Joel S Goldsmith

Simon Peter obviously Experienced [Saw and Knew in Spiritual Communion] the Christ directly from The Father which is in Heaven. And so we go and do likewise—practice, Commune and Know... ~Al Denninger

The Daily Lesson – March 28, 2023

“We are taught that the Pilgrim Fathers came to the New World to find religious freedom. There is nothing further from the truth than that. Our Pilgrim Fathers did not come here for religious freedom. They came to seek an opportunity to preach a religion of their own and to make everybody conform to it. The moment anybody dared to disagree with their religious practices, even though they, themselves, had been dissenters, he was forced out of the colony. There was little of religious freedom in those early days. Anyone who, like Roger Williams would not conform to the established religion was exiled from the colony because the colonists would permit no deviation from their prescribed form of worship.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – March 29, 2023

“It is not in the nature of most people to want religious freedom. What they really want is the freedom to practice their own religion, and then to force it upon the rest of mankind. That was the Colonists' interpretation of religious liberty. At the first Thanksgiving, the Pilgrims gave thanks, not because they had found a land where they could practice religious freedom, but because they had found a land where they could practice their own particular form of religion. They gave thanks for an effect, for something in the visible realm. Had the gratitude of the Pilgrim Fathers been of the kind that we are being taught, it would have been for a principle of real freedom, a principle so universal, so impersonal, that they would have extended it equally to all men. Then their gratitude would have been for cause, for principle, for universal good. But it was not that kind of gratitude. It was for their own safety, their own security, and for the right to do as they pleased.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – March 30, 2023

“We, in the twentieth century, must examine our own attitude toward the giving of thanks. Instead of being grateful that we have a United States of America which is comparatively free, our gratitude should be for a sense of spiritual freedom which is God-given, and which can never be interfered with by ‘man, whose breath is in his nostrils,’ nor by any form of government that he may devise. Governments change; administrations come and go; and if our gratitude rests on a satisfaction in these forms and only in the forms, we may find ourselves rudely awakened. The forms can too easily shift from our concept of good to our concept of evil. Therefore, instead of being grateful for the *effect*—some human form of government—we, on the spiritual path, have learned that our gratitude should be for a *principle* of government, and for the fact that we have discovered enough about the principle to maintain it and sustain it in individual and collective consciousness so that no man or group of men can tear it down. When we learn this, we shall have learned a higher sense of gratitude.” ~Joel s Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – April 1, 2023

“There was a time when it was thought that only ‘masters’ had access to this principle. One had to be a priest, a rabbi, or a minister in order to know this great principle of healing. Then, everyone else would come along and say, ‘Oh, how wonderful you are! Please do me this great favor!’ Today, this principle of life, which includes the principle of healing and the principle of multiplying loaves and fishes, is available to you and to me. Nobody has a monopoly on it. Even the copyrights on our Infinite Way books are only for the particular words used in presenting this principle. But that same principle can be stated in your own words for which you, too, can secure a copyright. Nobody can copyright or patent the idea of spiritual healing, or the idea of multiplying loaves and fishes. It is an open secret, and it is available to everybody. The Daily Lesson – April 2, 2023

“Certainly, there are loaves and fishes connected with this work. You, as an individual, must go within your own being, and pray and pray and pray for the Father within to reveal to you your teacher and your teaching. You will not be misled if you go within. Pray; pray; pray within your own being! Turn to the Father within and say: ‘Show me my teacher! Show me my teaching!’ Then, when you are led to some teaching, stay with it—and not just because you have a healing. It is good to be grateful. There is nothing finer than a sense of gratitude for the work that someone has done for you, especially when it has borne fruit. But there is something higher. Do not be satisfied. Turn within; go deeper. If you have received help, ask, ‘You have worked this miracle! Now tell me how you did it. Show me. Teach me.’ And if there is a spiritual spark in you, it will not be too long before you will be performing the same miracles.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

If you have a well-developed intellect, you may learn the letter of it very quickly and then be disappointed when it does not work. So you may complain, ‘I know all there is to be known, but I do not get the healing!’ In that case, you have not gone far enough. You have to go deep enough until you reach that point where your heart is touched, where your Spirit is quickened, where the Christ comes to life. That is not accomplished through mere intellectual attainment.” ~Joel S Goldsmith

“In either case, be patient! Let your heart tell you when you have found your teacher, and then be patient! Stay on the path, and catch the vision of this principle. Then you will have fulfilled the mission that Jesus came to earth to prove. He did not come to earth to multiply loaves and fishes for the poverty-stricken people of the world.
