The Daily Lesson – October 10, 2023

"Chapter 2

"Whether at this moment that being is appearing as a friend, a prisoner in a prison, a sick person in a hospital or in a mental institution, regardless of what the appearance may be, the basic point is that God constitutes individual being. God alone appears as individual being in whom there is no fault." ~Joel S Goldsmith

The Daily Lesson – October 26, 2023

"Often when we are dealing with our friends, our relatives, our students, or our patients, we are prone to revert to a human sense of criticism and judgment or to the metaphysical sense of believing that there is something in their minds—perhaps their wrong thinking—that has to be corrected. That is true, but not true as generally understood. It is not their wrong thinking about a person, thing, or condition that needs to be corrected. The only thing that has to be corrected is the same thing that has to be corrected in all of us: the belief in two powers, the belief that God is not omnipotent, that God is not omniscient and omnipresent." ~Joel S Goldsmith

The moment the human mind takes thought of a self other than God it seems to believe that it is somehow disconnected Spiritually from God's Presence. Accepting a lie cannot block or negate the Truth—the Truth is always True and Present—but entertaining a lie sure can temporarily distract us from Seeing the Truth. To break through, enter into stillness and desire nothing but to Know God aright and Be in His Presence. Omnipresence Is—be still, receptive and Know It. ~Al Denninger

The Daily Lesson – October 27, 2023

"The whole theory of resentment causing rheumatism, jealousy causing cancer, or sensuality causing tuberculosis is non-sense—pure nonsense. Those who accept a psychosomatic cause for disease find that they do not know how to get rid of the negative qualities of human thought to which all of us are heir, even after they have diagnosed this negativism as cause. The only way to be rid of these undesirable qualities is through understanding that they are not personal: they are impersonal; they are not power; they have no law to sustain them." ~Joel S Goldsmith

It is impersonal, and the very moment that we understand and declare it to be impersonal, we begin to separate it from ourselves. We take the condemnation from off our own shoulders, much as the Master did when he said to the woman taken in adultery, 'Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.' How her face must have lighted! Can you imagine the condemnation in which she was holding herself by believing that she was an adulteress, a sinner, and a criminal? But here was a man, the greatest spiritual light of the ages, saying to her, 'Neither do I condemn thee.'" ~Joel S Goldsmith

John 8:1-11 KJV

- 1 Jesus went unto the mount of Olives.
- 2 And early in the morning he came again into the temple, and all the people came unto him; and he sat down, and taught them.
- 3 And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,
- 4 They say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act.
- 5 Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou?

- 7 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- 8 And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.
- 9 And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.
- 10 When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?
- 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

This-world judgment dissolves in the Presence of the Christ. The forgiveness of the Christ is unconditional Love because there is no conditional error to behold in His Pure Eyes. Christs' Forgiveness is Impersonal because His Kingdom is not of this world where moth and rust doeth corrupt. If the appearance is a lie, is there anything to forgive or condemn? Forgive yourself for being momentarily distracted and drop it. ~Al Denninger

He did not deny that the enemy had men, equipment, and weapons; he merely said that they had temporal weapons, temporal arms, 'an arm of flesh.' ~Joel s Goldsmith

II Chronicles 32:1-8 KJV

- 1 After these things, and the establishment thereof, Sennacherib king of Assyria came, and entered into Judah, and encamped against the fenced cities, and thought to win them for himself.
- 2 And when Hezekiah saw that Sennacherib was come, and that he was purposed to fight against Jerusalem,
- 3 He took counsel with his princes and his mighty men to stop the waters of the fountains which were without the city: and they did help him.
- 4 So there was gathered much people together, who stopped all the fountains, and the brook that ran through the midst of the land, saying, Why should the kings of Assyria come, and find much water?
- 5 Also he strengthened himself, and built up all the wall that was broken, and raised it up to the towers, and another wall without, and repaired Millo in the city of David, and made darts and shields in abundance.
- 6 And he set captains of war over the people, and gathered them together to him in the street of the gate of the city, and spake comfortably to them, saying,
- 7 Be strong and courageous, be not afraid nor dismayed for the king of Assyria, nor for all the multitude that is with him: for there be more with us than with him:
- 8 With him is an arm of flesh; but with us is the Lord our God to help us, and to fight our battles. And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah king of Judah.

And so the appearance presents its lie again today. We must rest again in the words of Hezekiah and trust God first, often and always. Be strong and courageous by being still and Rest in the Omnipotence of God—exactly the same way that the people of Jerusalem did thousands of years ago. Any arm of flesh [temporal power] has no power in God's Kingdom. Truth remains constant.
